2022 Open Class Information

1. Pre-Registration is recommended. Please submit entry form on the website under the "Open Class" tab OR mail entry form to PO Box 413 ATTN: Justine Halvorson. Don't forget to keep a copy before sending in.
2. No late entries accepted. All exhibitors must report to the fair office before 8pm on Tuesday, July 26th. Please make entries early.
3. A proper entry of all articles and exhibitors must receive an exhibitor number. A number will be available the day of entry, near the open class buildings. All exhibitors will receive a card with their number. On the entry of the articles a tag will be furnished with exhibitor number, division, department, and class. The tag will be attached to the article to be exhibited. Exhibitor must retain their number until the close of the fair, and on presentation to the superintendent in charge of the department, the exhibitor may get their article.
4. Where there is but a single exhibitor in any lot, one premium will be paid. When there are two exhibitors and two exhibits shown, two premiums will be awarded. Nothing can be entered as special if not listed in the premium list.
5. When articles are not deemed worthy, the judges will refuse to award a premium, whether there be competition or not in the class.
6. All articles will be displayed in a well guarded, clean, dry showcase.

Rules & Regulations

1. All open class exhibitors are welcome! These rules apply to all departments unless permission has been obtained from the secretary.
2. EXHIBITS MAY NOT BE REMOVED UNTIL 5PM ON SUNDAY, July 31st.
3. The board will interpret these rules and decide all questions of fact in connection herewith. All questions in dispute or differences not covered by these rules shall be referred to the board, whose decision shall be final.
4. The management will take every precaution in its power for the protection of articles on exhibition, but will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur during their delivery, removal, and while on the grounds.
5. The fair board reserves the right to remove or deny any entry of any exhibit which may be deemed inappropriate. Articles can be shown only in one lot. One entry per person per lot, unless otherwise stated.
6. Articles must be entered in the name of the bona fide owner.
7. Judging of exhibits will start at 8:00am on Wednesday, July 27th
8. All exhibitors who wish to go in and out of the fairgrounds after entry time must have season tickets. Exhibitors' season tickets to the grounds can be purchased at the secretary's office.
9. The judge may select high quality exhibits for special meritorious ribbons.

10. All crops must have been grown in 2021 - 2022.
11. Master gardeners can answer your questions regarding showmanship, vegetable trimming, etc.
12. **PHOTOGRAPHY RULE:** All submitted photos must be 5x7 or 8x10, framed or matted. 1 print per related subject and must be taken within the last year.

Awards

1. The superintendent of the department or some other person appointed shall assist the awarding committee as clerk and shall keep a record of awards made. The record, when completed, shall be signed by the awarding committee and returned to the secretary as the final complete evidence of the award made.
2. The awards of the entries shall be denoted by ribbons, tags, or cards as follows: First Premium-Blue; Second Premium-Red.
3. All awards shall be made by comparison of the individual merits of the entries.
4. Any interference by exhibitors to influence or dictate the decision of the judge will be sufficient cause for excluding the entry from competition and should be reported to the secretary through the superintendent of the division.
5. No appeal from the decision of the awarding committee will be allowed.
6. Premiums will not be awarded on articles of inferior merit, regardless of the number of competitors for a premium. The judge may award no premium, second or first as merit may warrant—stating reasons for such placing.
7. No person shall be permitted to distribute advertising matter on the grounds except from his or her place of business or exhibit. The tacking or posting of any advertisement other than within the space occupied by the exhibitor is strictly prohibited. The distribution of handbills, flyers, heralds, etc., will not be permitted. Anyone violating this rule will be liable to a fine and expulsion from the grounds as the board may elect.
8. If the receipts should prove insufficient to meet all demands, the fair board reserves the right to first pay all bona fide expenses of the fair and pay premiums pro rata with the balance on hand.
9. The Minnesota State Horticultural Society will provide a special ribbon to the award winning youth (under 16) horticulture exhibit. Please indicate youth when entering.

GUIDE FOR VEGETABLE EXHIBITS

Uniformity of size, shape, color, and maturity. Vegetables should be labeled giving variety name.

Properly Cleaned:

- Root and leafy crops, if needed wash very gently in cool water.
- Tender-skinned vegetables such as peas, beans, summer squash, peppers, tomatoes, and eggplant should just be wiped clean with a soft cloth if needed.
- Cucumbers and onions should never be washed. Brush with a soft brush if needed.

Trim tops:

- Carrots, beets, parsnips, and onions to 1" to 1 ½."

Trim roots:

- Carrots and parsnips to 17"
- Beets, rutabagas, and turnips to 1" to 3" from the ball.

Special:

- Onions should be dry and never peeled.
- Cabbage should have 2 or 3 wrapper leaves remaining
- Peppers, eggplant, and summer squash leave ½" stem
- Tomatoes and muskmelon remove stem.
